SWRCB Policy and Initiatives – New Recycled Water Policy, Draft Statewide Recycled Water Landscape Irrigation Permit, and Blue Ribbon Task Force on Constituents of Emerging Concern

Jonathan Bishop, Chief Deputy Director of the State Water Resources Control Board, will present a brief presentation on the State Board's Water Recycling (WR) Policy, adopted February 3, 2009; the recently posted DRAFT Statewide Recycled Water Landscape Irrigation Permit; and the recently appointed Blue Ribbon Task Force on Constituents of Emerging Concern (CEC), which was called for the WR Policy.
