### **Meeting Topic: The SWRCB Draft Water Recycling Policy - Why This Document is so Important to Southern California**

The State Water Resources Control Board this month releases its Draft Water Recycling Policy. This policy document is a long-time coming and takes an important step forward in putting forth the policy issues that surround the challenge of increasing the use of recycled water in southern California and the State. The Policy addresses the use of recycled water for both irrigation and groundwater recharge. It proposes a requirement that all regions managing their groundwater basins for salt produce a salt management plan that will guide the monitoring and protection of groundwater basins, no matter what the source of the water. Expanded use of recycled water and groundwater basins for water storage is a vital strategy for meeting water demands. Come hear about the issues and share your views!
