








Urban River




Our Mission

Why People Volunteer

- 86% Feeling compassion for people in need
- 72% Have an interest in the type of work
- 70% It makes you feel good
- 70% It gives you a new perspective
- 67% It is important and helps a community
- 63% The importance of the activity for those in need
