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


Typical Measures Under Consideration


- Remove concrete
- Widen channel
- Reshape channel to add capacity
- Terrace banks
- Slope back channel banks
- Riparian corridors
- Create side channels with riparian/wetlands habitat
- Restore tributary confluences with riparian habitat
- Bring channel bank down to river level and create riparian habitat

- Daylight storm drains and add natural confluence with the river
- storm water treatment wetlands
- Connect to green streets with freshwater marsh
- Restructure channel banks and vegetate
- Add overhanging vines to top edge of channel banks
- Create backwater wetlands
- Deepen channel
- Lower channel banks
- Provide setback levees

















Study Schedule
