




EBMUD Pilot Launched June 2012

Cumulative Percent Saved




Requested Onsite Water Consultation




DOLLARS PER ACRE FOOT PURCHASED/SAVED

Period	Cumulative % savings for period	Total water saved per customer	Total Annual Usage (Baseline)
Year 1	6.1 %	3,420 gallons	56,100 gallons
Year 2	6.5 %	3,665 gallons	56,100 gallons
