LA's Groundwater Cleanup Accelerates

The Water Dialogue will spotlight two ambitious groundwater remediation and replenishment projects – LADWP's remediation of a San Fernando Valley Superfund site that will soon provide much needed water storage for the region, and WRD's WIN Project that has succeeded in its goal of not using imported water for replenishment since 2019.

The LADWP has deployed three treatment facilities at the Superfund site to filter up to 87,000 AFY or nearly a fifth of what LA consumes in a year with the goal of increasing to 70% by 2035. Water recycling and stormwater capture projects will contribute to reaching the goals. In turn, WRD's WIN 4 All (Water Independence Now) Program groundwater replenishment demands are entirely sourced from local recycled water and captured stormwater, thereby eliminating the use of imported water for replenishment. WIN 4 ALL will utilize groundwater aquifers to create a locally sustainable water supply for the Los Angeles Basin Region.
