### **Capturing Stormwater – Can't We Do Better?**

In a region that imports 60% of its water, capturing and storing stormwater is essential to increasing local supply. Yet only a fraction of the billions of gallons that descend from the skies is captured and stored in groundwater basins. Can we do better and, if so, how?

The Water Dialogue panelists will delve into how much stormwater current regional projects capture, how much more could be captured in the future, and whether we can accelerate the pace of project completion. The panel also will discuss the value of stormwater for wetlands, ocean water quality, and aquatic species.
