Taming Catastrophic Wildfires

Catastrophic wildfires have already swept the state with over 1-million acres burned. This year's unusually hot fall reminds us that the worst of the fire season is yet to come.

Join renown wildfire and forest management experts as they share new strategies and innovations being implemented to create more wildfire resilient ecosystems in both southern and northern California. Speakers will address how water yield can be increased and post-fire water quality improved, recent advances in estimating and reducing risk, the value of increasing prescribed burns and restoration thinning, and the urgent need for additional state and federal government funding and action.
